| Course Content / Learning Outcomes | <p>This class program includes 3 types of reading; (1) Intensive Reading (textbook), (2) Reading for Fluency (provided passages) and (3) Extensive reading (choice of reading)</p> <p>The three types of reading encourage students to read for enjoyment, fluency/speed and for educational/learning purposes, each combining to teach necessary reading skills, while becoming more confident/faster in comprehending texts being read.</p> <p>Through reading a variety of materials, students will learn to comprehend and summarize passages, extend their vocabulary knowledge, and refine grammatical skills, for use in written or speaking tasks.</p> | | | | | | |
